$10 > 5$

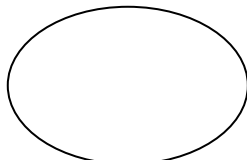
*"10 is **greater than** 5"*

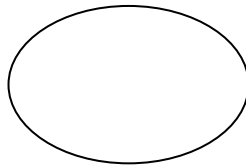
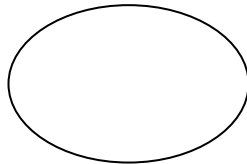
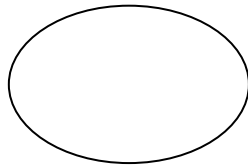
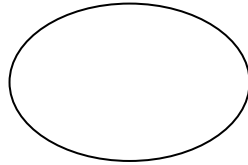
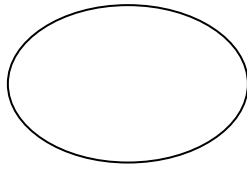
$5 < 10$
