

## Home Learning Activities

### Year 1 – Maths, ‘Capacity’

Find a container and a plastic cup. You are going to fill this container with cups of water. How many cups do you think it will take to fill it to the top? Fewer than 5? More than 5? More than 10?

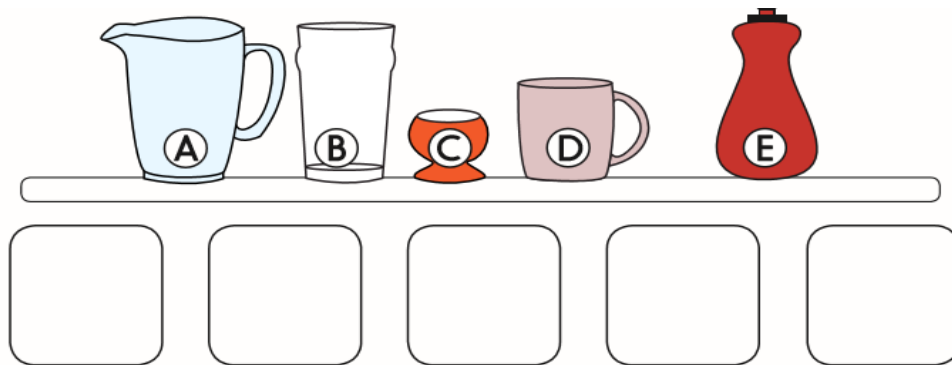
Fill the cup and pour it into the container. Repeat until the container is full, counting the number of cups needed to fill it. Stick a post it on the container showing how many cups it takes.

Repeat this activity with at least another two containers, filling them and counting how many cups it takes.

Now order each container from least capacity to greatest.

Draw and label the containers in order and write a sentence to explain which holds the most/least.

Order the containers below from the one that holds the most to the one that holds the least.



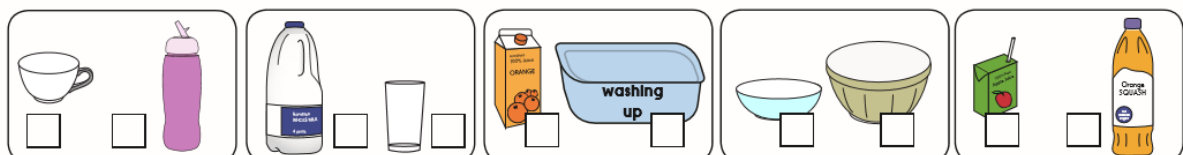
Which containers hold less than the pint glass?

Which containers hold more than the washing up bottle?

Can you think of any more containers that would hold more than the jug?

Can you think of any other containers that hold less than the eggcup?

Now tick the containers that would hold the most water.
