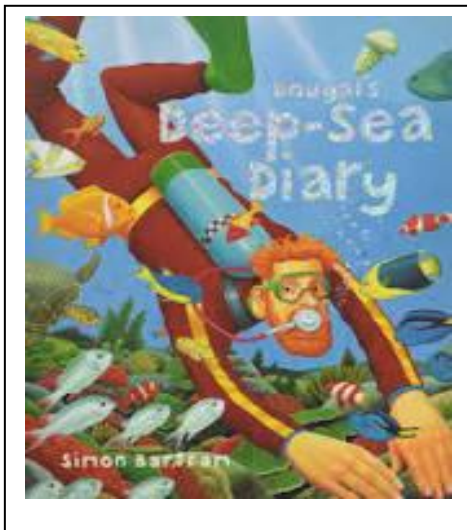




Home Learning Activities

I have written an example below, which your grown up could read with you.

Tuesday: I played with the dolphins today. They can jump very high.



Wednesday: I dived deep down today and found a chest of sparkly jewels.



Thursday: I collected lots of beautiful shells today. They were all different shapes and sizes.



Friday: I followed a sea turtle today and we found a dark cave.



I hope you have fun creating your own exciting diary. You can add pictures too if you like. I look forward to reading all about what you got up to on your dive.
