Maths Activity 1 Making 10 and 20

Colour and complete the number bonds to 10 and 20 rainbows and then play this fun addition game to practice adding to make totals of 10 and 20.


You will need:

- A game board
- 6 dice x 1
- Two writing pencils
- Two different coloured pencils

How to play:

- Play this game with a partner. Choose your coloured pencil.
- Take it in turns to roll the dice and write the number it lands on in one of the squares on your game board.
- You can write two, three or more numbers in a square.
- You can write numbers in any square, even if there are numbers written in it by the other player.
- If you write a number in a square that makes the total of numbers in that square 10, you win that square.
- Circle your winning square with your coloured pencil.
- The first person to circle three squares in a line, in any direction, wins!
- If this game gets too easy, why don't you try it with squares that must total 20?
