



Find totals using number facts.

At the toy shop



Use a number fact to add these two prices.
 $15p + 5p = 20p$

Use a double to add these two prices.
Double 6p is 12p

Count on to add these two prices.
 $19p + 7p = 26p$

Item prices: 19p, 15p, 6p, 10p, 8p, 5p, 13p, 12p, 9p, 1p, 11p, 7p, 10p, 6p, 7p, 14p.


Questions to talk about together.

How much does the watergun and the crayons cost altogether? How did you work it out?

How much is the toy car and the bag of marbles altogether? What number facts did you use to solve this problem?

Find totals using number facts.

At the toy shop



Choose two toys to buy. Add the amounts together.

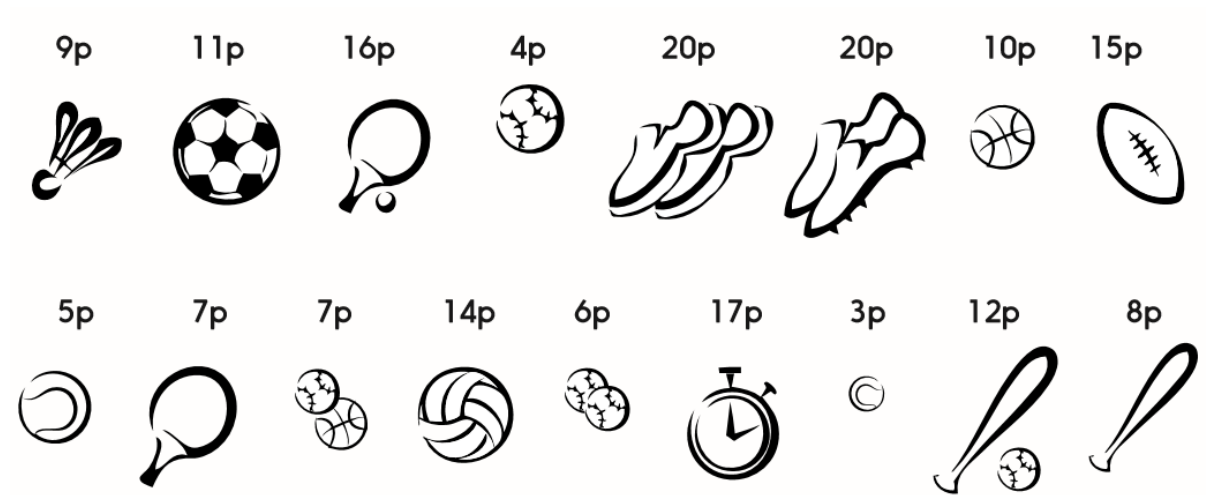
Use number facts that you know, e.g. doubles, number bonds to 10 or 20, or counting on from the larger number.

Item prices: 19p, 15p, 6p, 10p, 8p, 5p, 13p, 12p, 9p, 1p, 11p, 7p, 10p, 6p, 7p, 14p.

Pick two toys and add their amounts together. Can you explain to a grown up which number facts you used to help you find the total quickly.

Choose at least 5 pairs of items from the sports shop. Add up each pair of items. What is their total?

Don't forget to use known number facts to help you.



Example

The football and the shuttlecock.

$$11p + 9p = 20p$$

You could choose some items in your house and make price labels for them and make a small shop. Pick two items and add up their amounts to make a total. You could send pictures of your shop and your number sentences to match.
