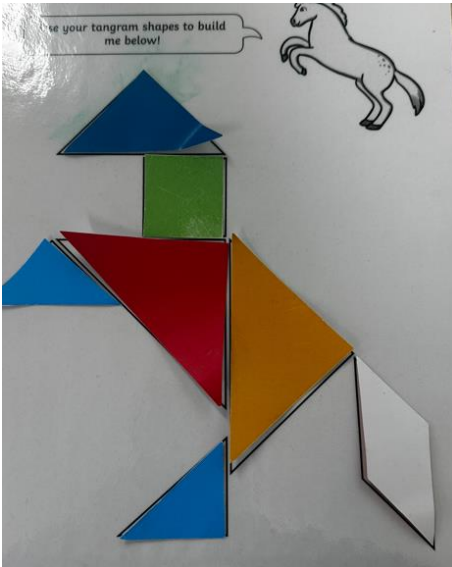

Year R
