Spotlight on Learning


YR

In Literacy, the children have been learning about Bonfire Night. They used their senses to describe what they could see, hear and taste at a bonfire event.

In Maths, the children have been learning about representing 4 and 5 in different ways.

Y1

In English the Y1 children have been learning the story and enjoying the repetitive patterns in Room on the Broom. In Maths they have been calculating missing numbers in wholepart models.



Y2

This week in Music, the Y2 children have been learning how to play the B note on the recorders and have been practising call and response.

In Maths they have been learning about exchanging when adding and subtracting. They have also been using key words in a word problem to help them to identify whether it is addition or subtraction.


They have been using iPads in Computing to take pictures in landscape and portrait. They
