

Spotlight on Learning

YR

This week in Literacy the children learnt about Pancake Day (Shrove Tuesday). The children read instructions on how to make their batter and decorate their pancakes.



In Maths they have been learning about finding and representing 9 and 10 in different ways.



Y1

This week the children have started to learn about numbers to 50, looking carefully at the tens and ones in these numbers. They have been practising counting in tens too!

In English the children have planned and written a report on penguins and shown how knowledgeable they are about them!

In Science and DT the children are building kites and looking how they can

make a stronger structure using different

materials.



Y2

In English, the children have written their postcards as Sunny the meerkat. They wrote about him visiting our school and what he did and saw.

In Maths, they have been practising doubling and having using pictures to help them and writing the corresponding multiplication and division facts.



In Science the children answered the question 'Where do woodlice prefer to live?' and used our outdoor environment to collect data.

In Geography, the children went out into the local area to carry out fieldwork and surveyed the houses in the local area and collected data to show the most common types of houses.
