

Spotlight on Learning

In Maths the children have been learning about circles and triangles. They can talk about how they know the shape is a circle or triangle by describing the properties of the shapes.


Y1

This week in Year 1 the children have started looking at the materials that objects are made from. They went outside to find items around the school made from metal, wood, plastic and glass. In English the children have been working on The Gruffalo's Child, and Maths they have learning their number bonds to 10!



Y2

This week in Maths, the children have been adding and subtracting one-digit numbers from two-digit numbers using bonds to 10 to simplify the calculation. In computing they've been learning about taking digital photos in portrait and landscape and how this can improve the photo.



In PSHE, the children have been thinking about the different types of bullying and reading the story 'Something Else' to help us understand how being made to feel different can make someone feel.
