INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

We are welcoming back our 'Rainbow Reading Rewards' scheme - starting this week, Wednesday 17th January.

This applies to all children in school and reminds them how important reading at home is for their learning. Here's how it works:

- Each time your child reads at home, we need you to sign their reading record diary. Reading at home can be a book, comic, menu, sign, recipe, shopping list...the list is endless!
- We will collect in your child's diary each week and record how many times they have read - a maximum of twice per day will be counted
- Your child will receive a special mention in All Stars assembly, a certificate and small prize for every 25 reads at home - these will match the colours of the rainbow, e.g. for 25 reads, they will get a red certificate and a prize, for 50 reads this will be orange, etc.
- When they have collected all colours of the rainbow, they will receive their special GOLD certificate and prize from the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow :-)

The children will hear about our new Rainbow Rewards in a special assembly and hopefully will then be excited to read to you at home.

Please remember - by hearing your child read at home just 3 times a week, you will be improving their reading ability...
