

Democracy

Children are involved in a democratic process for choosing school council members. Council members take ideas of their peers to meetings and are trusted to put them forward to the council

Class discussions in curriculum lessons (incl PSHE) where children feel valued and safe to voice and offer opinions

Pupil voice is clear in curriculum interviews

Class-based rules are decided upon by class groups to compliment school rules

Children are encouraged to vote on class rewards for completing animal charts
