In English we will learn:

- * To choose vocabulary to create description when writing about a setting.

In Geography we will learn:

Enquiry: Why does it matter where my food comes from?

- To identify physical and human features.
- To compare weather climates.
- To use a map to locate countries and oceans.

In RE we will learn:

- To know what Muslims believe and what is important to them.
- To re-tell a story about the life of Prophet Muhammad.

In PE we will learn:

- Tennis

In Maths we will learn:

- * To count forwards and backwards to 50, to know the value digits in two- digit numbers using equipment, to compare and order numbers, to count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10, to use number bonds to support addition and subtraction.

In Science we will learn:

- * That materials can be used for more than one thing.
- Why the properties of materials matter for their purpose.
- * That materials can be changed.

In PSHE we will learn:

- * To understand the importance of rules and why we have them.
- * To understand what our responsibilities are at school and at home.
- * To understand what democracy means and value to opinions and views of others.

In Computing we will learn:

- What is IT and the common uses of IT in school and the wider world.
- To know how to use IT safely.

In DT we will learn:

- To generate and develop ideas to make a 'drawbridge hinge and lever' by selecting from materials.

In Music we will learn:

- Pulse
- To develop their listening skills by recognising and marking the pulse in music, including music which changes tempo.
- To begin learning how to notate rhythm using stick notation and create their own 4 bar, 4/4 rhythm in groups to perform.
