We will be exploring animals and plants in our natural environment as well as those in a contrasting environment. We will describe different habitats and think about why it is important to look after the natural world. We will also learn the key features of a lifecycle such as; the lifecycle of a hen.</p>

The children will work with familiar 3D shapes such as cardboard boxes to make a house for the 3 Little Pigs.
