In Literacy, we will:

- Be listening to nursery rhymes and stories.
- Be learning to recognise our name.
- Be learning some letter sounds.
- Listening to sounds in our environment.

In Maths, we will be focussing on:

- Matching and sorting
- Saying whether an amount is more or fewer.
- Exploring size, mass and capacity
- 1,2,3

In Understanding the World we will:

- Talk about things that we did at the weekend, yesterday, this morning...
- Talk about members of our own family and immediate community.
- Listen to sounds outside and find where they come from.
- Explore the outdoor area and make simple observations and comments.

In Communication and Language we will learn:

- Join in with key words and phrases from stories and rhymes.
- Wait and begin to take turns in conversations with adults and peers.
- Answer simple questions and understand some 'why' questions.

In PSHE, we will:

- Think about people who are special to us and how they care for us.
- Learn what makes a good friend.

In Physical Development we will be:

- Learning to use different body parts when moving and different ways of moving.
- Learning how to hold a tennis racquet and hit a ball.

In Expressive Art and Design, we will:

- Use paint and pencils to create observational drawings; such as self-portraits.
- Make marks / rubbings / lines / shapes with different materials and different surfaces.
- Explore different malleable materials.
- Learn the colour names.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will learn:

- Increasingly follow rules, understanding why they are important.
- Be beginning to work and play cooperatively and take turns with others.
