<p><b>In English we will learn to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read sentences independently that are consistent with their phonic knowledge</li><li>• Write sentences that can be read by themselves and others.</li><li>• Read and write taught common exception words.</li><li>• Form letters correctly.</li></ul>	<p><b>In Maths we will:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be learning how to double a number and share a group.</li><li>• Identify the difference between an odd and even number.</li><li>• Visualise and describe positions to support building and map work</li><li>• Be learning about patterns and relationships</li></ul>	<p><b>In Science we will learn:</b></p> <p>Look at the effect of the changing season: Summer and explore making shadows. We will also be learning about the differences between some materials and we will explore which will float and which will sink.</p>
<p><b>In Geography we will learn to:</b></p> <p>Draw and create simple maps. <p><b>In RE we will:</b></p> <p>Be learning and talking about stories that are special to members of different faiths.</p>		<p><b>In Computing we will:</b></p> <p>Be using Apps and technology to support our learning in Music.</p>
<p><b>In Music we will:</b></p> <p>Learn the key features of country music, big band music and beatboxing.
