Year R

The children have really enjoyed listening to lots of different Christmas stories in English, looking at sequencing a story after we have read it.

In Maths the children have continued to strengthen their knowledge of numbers 0-5. They have been looking at 1 more and 1 less and what the words more and less mean.

Year 1

Year 1 have been completing their Big Writes in English this week, and we are really proud of them! They have all been using their sounds to spell words independently, and have used full stops and capital letters so that their writing makes sense. In Maths they have been consolidating their understanding of number bonds to 10. They have been working systematically to make sure that they can identify them all.
