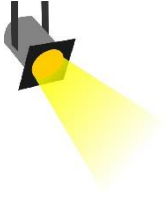

Spotlight on Learning

Year R

This week we have been looking at the Christian Creation Story and how Christians believe that God made the world in 7 days. The children have been making mini books and watercolour paintings of the parts of the story.

In maths we have been finding and representing 9 and 10. We have been noticing what is 10 and what is not 10!

Year 1

We have finished our non-chronological reports all about penguins. We know so much information that we couldn't fit it all into our reports!

In Maths we have continued to get even better with fact families. The children have continued to use number bonds within 10 to help them with numbers to 20.

We worked extremely hard to follow our design plans and decorate our puppets. We cannot wait to show our grown ups!

Year 2

This week Year 2 have been learning how to use arrays to multiply and divide. They are beginning to see the link between multiplication and division facts. We have been multiplying by 2 and dividing by 2 and understand that this is also called doubling and halving.

For Internet Safety day, we learnt about the safe and responsible use of AI. We learnt that AI can be a useful tool when used correctly but learnt about scenarios which wouldn't be a good use. We know to be honest about work produced using AI, and not to use it to upset other people. We know that not everything AI tells is accurate and that we should check our sources. We know to ask an adult before using AI and speak to them if something makes us feel worried or upset.

In RE, we had a visit from Miss Hassan to our class to talk to us about Ramadan and Eid. We had questions prepared and she answered them using her own experiences and explained what Muslims believe and how they prepare for Ramadan and what happens during Eid celebrations.

In DT, the children have been finishing sewing their bags. They have evaluated them to decide what went well and how they could be improved.
