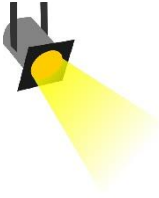

Spotlight on Learning

Year R

This week we have been really enjoying learning about Minibeasts! We found out some really interesting facts, some that we couldn't believe were true!

We have been writing sentences about our favourite minibeasts using finger spaces and correct letter formation.

In Maths we have been recapping our knowledge of number bonds to numbers within 10. We have been practising using our fingers to help us.

In outdoor learning we have searched for different minibeasts in the outdoor area. We found lots of different ones!

Year 1

In Year 1 this week we have started our new English topic on the book called 'The Old Woman and the Red Pumpkin'. This is a story set in India. We learnt about some new animals and foods that we hadn't even heard of before.

In Geography we have been learning all about the weather and the different types of weather that we can experience here in the UK.

Year 2

This week year 2 have been continuing their work on time, learning 5 minute intervals past and to the hour. We have been learning about writing instructions including key vocabulary such as time adverbials (First, then, next, after that) and imperative verbs (bossy verbs such as mix, pour, sit, take, turn) They verbally instructed each other to put on costumes and wrote down instructions using the features mentioned.
