Year 2 Leavers Disco

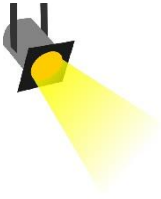

Spotlight on Learning

Year R

In Literacy the children have been learning about minibeasts. For their big writes the children have been creating their own minibeast fact files.

In Maths, the children have been deepening their understanding of different patterns. They have started to develop secure knowledge on pattern rules and learning to verbalise their thinking and explain it to others.

Year 1

In Maths we have been continuing to learn about money. We have been calculating using coins. E.g. 10 2p coins is equal to 20p

In English we have been innovating and writing our final stories from a different culture.

In History we visited the Great Central Railway and the children got to experience going on a steam train.

Year 2

This week year 2 have been reading The Proudest Blue and thinking about what they are proud of about themselves and what makes a good friend. This is preparation for writing to their new teachers next week.

We have moved on to data collection in Maths, using tally charts, tables, block diagrams and pictograms to show information.

In Science, we have set up an experiment about the conditions of growth where we have planted seeds in different conditions such as without water, without light, cold temperature and reducing air supply. We will observe and see what happens!

In history, we have started learning about Alice Hawkins - a suffragette who campaigned tirelessly for women's rights and equality. There is a statue of her in Green Dragon Square in Leicester where she did much of her public speaking.
