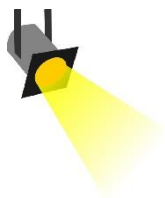

Year R

This week in Squirrels we have been exploring the magical worlds of fairies and wizards. We have been reading an excellent story called The Tree Keepers about small magical creatures who look after the trees. We had a go at making a story map with Mrs Jones and the next day we changed one of the characters in the story to make it our own.

In Maths we have been looking at the vocabulary of position. We have made our own maps and talked about them using vocabulary such as underneath, in between, opposite. Some of this was quite tricky but we have worked hard to learn new vocabulary.

Year 1

In English, the children have used their knowledge on past tense verbs, adjectives and time conjunctions to write their own recounts on their trip to the Great Central Railway.

In Maths, the children have been working really hard in their maths quizzes.

In science, the children have used their knowledge on the seasons to paint trees to match each season.

Year 2

In Year 2 we have been reading a poem by Benjamin Zephaniah called Nature Trail. We went on our own nature trail in our school forest area and wrote lots of nouns we could see and then wrote words to describe them. We also wrote words that rhyme with them. Next week we will use these ideas to write our own nature trail poems.

In Maths, we have learnt about position and direction, including left and right, clockwise, and anticlockwise and half, quarter, and three-quarter turns.

In PE, we have been practising hockey skills and cricket/rounder skills of hitting the ball and effectively fielding to get the ball back to the bowler.
